


Your preschoolers will be delighted with the things to do in this *Preschool Make-It/Take-It* book. It contains a variety of activities that are simple enough to be done by your children, with only a little help from you, the teacher. Complete instructions for you appear on the back of each project as well as in the teacher's guide.

Each project reinforces the lesson by showing children how to apply what they are learning in that day's lesson or by directly reviewing the Bible story. The child has a reminder of what was studied to take home at the end of the class period.

This booklet is designed to correlate with the *Preschool Teacher's Guide*, *Preschool Creative Teaching Aids*, and *My Sunday Pictures* lesson cards.

Supplies to have on hand: crayons, construction paper, teacher's scissors, paste or glue sticks (the sticks are less messy than paste), yarn, tape, cotton balls

Optional: camera and instant film (Lesson 1); flower and animal stickers (Lessons 2 and 6); flannel or other soft fabric scraps (Lesson 4, pattern for Lesson 6); paper clips (Lessons 7 and 11); large star stickers (Lesson 10); unpopped popcorn (Lesson 12); resealable plastic bags (Lesson 13)



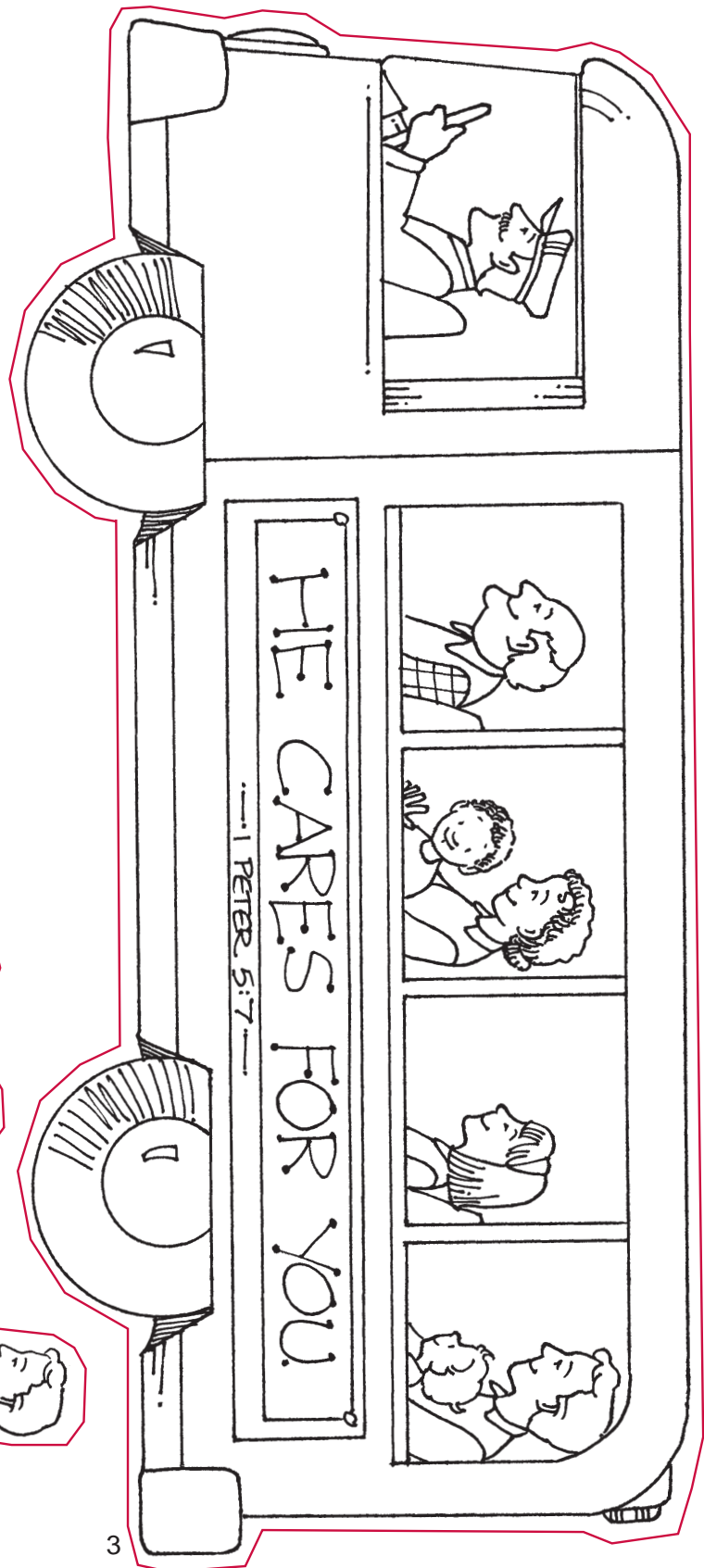
Here and on the inside of the back cover you will find helpful patterns ready for your children to color and use in simple projects related to the unit themes and specific lessons.

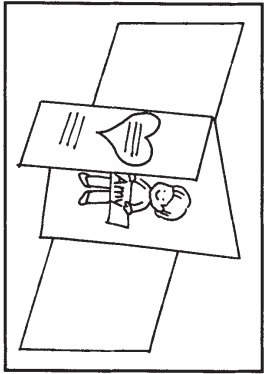
More suggestions for using these patterns are in your teacher's guide lessons. Feel free to adapt the different ideas in any way you wish to fit the needs of your class.

Patterns for Lessons 1 and 2

Use these patterns as Welcome Time Activities to remind your class that they are important to Jesus. For Lesson 1, let the children color the people figures. In Lesson 2, the children can color the bus.

For a bulletin board, you might draw a town with streets. Have the buses traveling down the streets toward people who are waiting at the bus stops.





FOR TEACHER

Before class:

- Remove this page from the book.
- Punch out the heart in the center of the heart-shaped frame. (These hearts will be used in a Welcome Time Activity as suggested in the teacher's guide.)
- Fold the page back on the broken line and then unfold it to make a crease as a guide for the child to follow.

During class:

- Let children color their cards.
- Help each child print his or her name on the sign inside the card that the child is holding.

Optional:

- Help children glue on yarn for hair to make the child in the picture look like themselves.
- Or take a photo that develops instantly and tape each child's

photo over the child's face on his card.

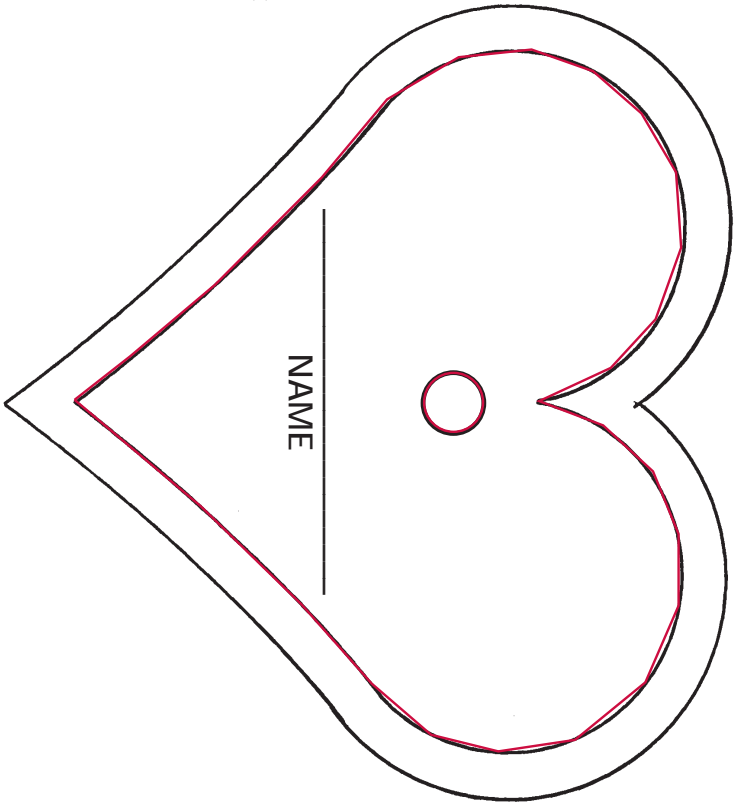
Talk about:

- The fact that we can be happy because Jesus knows who we are.
- The fact that we are important to Jesus.

FOR PARENTS

In class today the lesson was that Jesus knows who we are. Your child heard the Bible story about when Jesus talked with the Samaritan woman at a well (John 4:4-26).

At home this week, remind your child that Jesus knows who we are. Read this card aloud as a reminder of Jesus' love. Also help your child start to learn the Bible verse, "He cares for you" (1 Pet. 5:7).
