Jesus Talks with a Woman at a Well

This story is based on John 4:4-26.

Soon a woman who had a jar walked up to the well. Do you see her? Jesus said to the woman, "I'm thirsty. Will you give Me a drink of water?"

So the woman asked, "Why are You asking *me* for a drink?"

Jesus said, "I came to be a friend to everyone. If you love Me, I will always be your friend. You will never be alone."

Bible Words: He cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7



Bible Fun Feeling alone is frightening to a child. You can use this week's Bible story to reassure your child that Jesus knows who we are. To review the story, use toy figures and a bowl of water. You take the role of Jesus, and your child can be the Samaritan woman. As the woman is getting water from the well, have Jesus say, "I know who you are. Remember that I am with you and care for you." Then review the Unit Memory Verse together: "He cares for you."
